## Cocktails

The word cocktail is defined in Hudson, New York, 1806 as 'Cock tail' as " a stimulating liquor; composed of spirits of any kind, sugar, water and bitters"

### Bloody Mary

*Tomato/spice flavour*

A classic aperitif mix of vodka, tomato juice, lemon juice, a dash of Worcestershire sauce and Tabasco sauce and a pinch of salt and pepper. Originally created in 1921 and named after its creator Fernand Petoit, the spicy version is renamed as Bloody Mary

### Screwdriver

*Orange flavour*

A 1950's classic of vodka and orange juice named because a screwdriver was used to stir the brew made by US marines!

### Gimlet

*Lime flavour*

A mix of gin and lime cordial with crushed ice. Named after a small sharp hand tool used in bars to tap into barrels, the word gimlet was eventually used to describe a small sharp cocktail around 1930

### Tom Collins

*Lemon/gin flavour*

Dated as far back as 1738 this cocktail consists of gin with soda water and sugar with a dash of lemon juice and is also known as Collins and a Gin Collins

### Daiquiri

*Citrus/sour flavour*

Originally created in Cuba in 1896 and named after a town, this cocktail is a mix of white rum, lime juice and sugar

### Pina Colada

*Coconut/rum flavour*

Probably the most popular cocktail in the world this all time favourite originates from Puerto Rico in 1954 and is made with a blend of white rum (Malibu), sweetened coconut cream, double cream and pineapple juice

### Mint Julep

*Bourbon/mint flavour*

This classic drink dates as far back as 1987 and consists of Bourbon with sugar and garnished with mint leaves

### Black Jack

*Coffee flavour*

A rich cocktail drink made with cognac, kirsch, coffee liqueur and black coffee

### Tequila Sunrise

*Orange flavour*

The origin of this well-known cocktail can be traced back to Mexico in the early 1930s and consists of Tequila, Grenadine and orange juice

### Margarita

*Citrus flavour*

Named after actress Marjorie King in 1948, this classic Mexican drink is a mix of Tequila, Countreau and freshly squeezed lime juice

### Scotch Bounty

*Whiskey/coconut flavour*

Whiskey and Malibu mixed with orange juice and crème de cacao

### Manhattan

*Vermouth flavour*

Believed to be created around 1874 at the Manhattan Club in New York for Lady Randolph Churchill, Winston Churchill's mother. The drink is a unique blend of Bourbon whiskey, sweet vermouth and angostura, served either straight or on the rocks

### Blue Lagoon

*Orange/lemon flavour*

Created around 1960 in Paris when Blue Curacao had just appeared, this cocktail is a mix of vodka, blue curacao and lemonade

### Blue Hawaiian

*Pineapple/coconut flavour*

A blend of Blue Curacao, Malibu, pineapple juice and sweetened coconut cream with a glassful of crushed ice

### Casablanca

*Coconut flavour*

A smooth blend of Malibu, sweetened coconut cream, pineapple juice and a dash of grenadine with crushed ice

### Negroni

*Sour herb flavour*

Based on the popular Campari aperitif and named after Count Camillo Negroni in 1919 this is quite a bitter tasting cocktail mix of gin, sweet vermouth, Campari and soda water with ice
